RESEARCHERS AND SPONSORSHIP

- The application and generation of the database was conducted by Defoe, Experts on Social Reporting, S.C.
- The analysis and interpretation of data was carried out by SPIN-Taller de Comunicación Política, S.C.



OBJECTIVES

- Learn the impact of preelectoral surveys as a key piece of information about the competition situation of candidates during the 2018 presidential campaign in Mexico.
- Identify the effects of different types of stimuli related to four different electoral poll scenarios (strategic voting or bandwagon effect).
- Learn the socio-demographic characteristics and political preferences of participants who modify their vote intention once they're exposed to poll information.



WHAT IS AN EXPERIMENT AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

- In general experiments seek to make direct comparisons between the effect of different doses of stimuli (treatments), with the absence of these (controls), among a group of participants. A brief questionnaire is applied to the participants before separating them into groups and presenting them, simultaneoulsy, one of the treatments in a closed environment, and a new questionnaire is applied immediately after to learn the changes due to the participants' exposure to control or treatments.
- The measurement prior and after the treatment application allows direct asociation (causality) of the treatment effect with the change in candidates' responses to the entry and exit polls.



WHAT DIFFERENCES ARE THERE BETWEEN EXPERIMENTS AND SURVEYS?

- Experiments allow to establish a cause-effect relationship among variables, whilst surveys only show association between variables (correlation).
- Experiments do not need to be representative because they only seek for the effect of one or serveral treatments among the participants, who are interviewed before and after the treatments are applied.
- For several decades, Economics and, increasingly, Political Science, use experiments to complement designs that allow to have information to make more solid statements about research hyphothesis.



METHODOLOGY

- The <u>First DEFOE-SPIN Experiment</u> was conducted on April 14th and 15th 2018 with 240 participants, aged 40 to 70 (segments which have voted above population average in the last federal elections), who were recruited in three cities of Mexico: 80 in Mexico City, 80 in Guadalajara, Jalisco, and 80 in Boca del Río, Veracruz.
- The <u>First DEFOE-SPIN Experiment</u> measured the effect of four different scenarios derived from the publication of pre-election surveys, in which there is: a difference between first and second place, a difference between the second and third, and one more in which second and third place have a reversed order.

 - AMLO (40%) > ANAYA (30%) > MEADE (20%) > INDEPENDENTS (10%)






TREATMENT 1: AMLO > ANAYA = MEADE






TREATMENT 2: AMLO > ANAYA > MEADE






TREATMENT 3: AMLO > MEADE > ANAYA




DEVELOPMENT OF THE EXPERIMENT

- The participants were delivered a closed envelope with the same news about the format of the presidential debates and a survey –different acording to each one of the treatments and the control-, a blank card and a pen.
- Through the projection of a video, the participants were instructed to write down a brief summary on the blank card about the news and about the survey.
- All the participants, from the moment in which they received the envelope, during the entry poll, during the experiment and during the exit poll, were forbidden to speak in order to avoid contamining the results.



Con la inconformidad de los representantes de candidatos, la Comisión de Debates del Instituto Nacional Electoral (INE) aprobó ayer el formato y los moderadores del primer debate entre aspirantes a la Presidencia.

Según el formato aprobado, el primer debate, que se llevará a cabo en el Palacio de Minería de la Ciudad de México el 22 de abril, se dividirá en cuatro bloques para abordar igual número de temas: seguridad, corrupción e impunidad, democracia y grupos vulnerables, y política y gobierno.

Los cuatro bloques, que en total tendrán una duración de 1 hora con 54 minutos, serán divididos en dos segmentos: en el primero los moderadores cuestionarán a los candidatos, mientras que en el segundo habrá una mesa de diálogo entre los cuatro candidatos.

En el primer segmento de cada bloque cada uno de los candidatos tendrá 2 minutos con 30 segundos para contestar a los moderadores, quienes a su vez contarán con 30 segundos para hacer preguntas o interpelar; después habrá 4 minutos de

réplicas y contrarréplicas entre los abanderados.

En el segundo segmento Ricardo Anaya, Andrés Manuel López Obrador, José Antonio Meade y Margarita Zavala debatirán 8 minutos; al finalizar los cuatro bloques, los cuatro candidatos tendrán un minuto para cerrar.





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

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS APRIL-2018



SUMMARY OF FINDINGS (1/2)

- Survey information can in fact modify vote intention, as one of every three participants in the experiment modified his vote intention once they had access to a survey.
- By showing the participants of the experiment various survey scenarios, results obtained show that more than strategic (useful) vote to make the second place competitive, the participants preferred to reinforce the advantage of the winner, as shown in each of the cases:
 - Treatment 1, that shows a survey with a tie among candidates for the second and third place, doesn't reveal the existence of strategic voting effect.
 - Treatment 2, that shows a close competition between the first and secnd places, strengthens the first place, which reveals the existence of the bandwagon effect.



SUMMARY OF FINDINGS (1/2)

- Treatment 3, far from showing the strengthening of the second place (Meade before the experiment), takes votes from him, which could reveal an anti-PRI vote stronger than strategic voting in his favor.
- Control, which has a well-defined first, second and third place, shows that Anaya loses more votes to AMLO than Meade, which reveals the existence of the bandwagon effect.
- The survey scenarios used in the experiment (innovative exercise Mexico) reflect the results of the diverse surveys published so far.
- The experiement's participants show a greater propensity to strengthen the winner than to vote strategically to make the second place more competitive derived, perhaps, from the strong anti-PRI effect.













Regardless of who you voted for, which political party do you sympathize with the most? (% sum of "some" and "less").




